



Maison Kayser opens in NYC

There are few things that smell better than freshly baked bread. If you want a change from your typical supermarket bread, head over to [Maison Kayser Bakery](#) on the Upper East Side, which opened its doors on August 8, 2012. It's the first American shop for the [bakery](#), which has locations all across the globe, but was originally opened in Paris in 1996 by French Master Baker, Eric Kayser.

The first location in [NYC](#) is just the start. There are two more in the works – one right across from Bryant Park that's set to open next year and another on Broadway near 21st Street that's set to open in November. Their current location seats 104 people and, in addition to fresh bread, offers salads, sandwiches, pastries and various other French treats. However, you can't walk into the bakery without picking up the incredible baguette bread and croissants. You can't beat the prices, especially when you consider the quality you're getting.

Maison Kayser is located at 1294 Third Avenue. They're open Monday through Friday from 7a.m. to 11p.m. and on the weekend from 8a.m. to 11p.m.
